

Widmer Council Report for Feb 2016 Council Meeting

28 January- SBWMA Board meeting-a new Board Chairman was elected. The Board decided to ask the County to lead the search for a new Executive Director. The Board appointed Hilary Gains (an inside Director) as interim. The Board discussed the schedule for jurisdictions to consider plans for waste services from 2020 and on. This will be a topic at our upcoming March study session.

Attended Peninsula Clean Energy Advisory Board. Discussion indicated that the program was gaining good traction and it was anticipated that the advisory board would transition to a JPA in March. The meeting topics were a discussion on the Marin and Sonoma implementations. Major topics from rate positioning, to organizational structure and investment in local energy sources. Input was provided on the requested topics.

30 January-Attended memorial service for Clarice Merrill. It was attended by over 600 people including the County DA, County and regional police officers and many residents. Former Mayor Carlson and his wife were also in attendance.

1 February-Attended HP-Park Foundation meeting. Discussion included status and plans for the Event Garden project which has been hampered by rain. The committee was advised of the City's need to get the project complete. Several work plans were discussed and later reviewed with the CM.
